From the desk of the Youth Chaplain

Greetings in the matchless name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Parish is one of the units of the Church which is the body of Christ. It is the parish that reflects the ministry and mission of Jesus Christ.

But sometimes we the parish loses the focus on why God has established us a parish in a particular setting, culture and neighborhood. In the Bible we find, that the Corinthian Church also experience lots of problems. They had problems with regards to the unity of the church, differences in the way spiritual gifts were exercised and finally lot of issues with regards to the personal life of the believer. It is in such a context that Paul comes to the Corinthian Church and reminds them of their high calling and the unity that they need to maintain as the body of Christ. So as a parish I believe we need to emphasize on three aspects so that our parish life reflects the mission and ministry of our Lord.

The first element in a parish so that it functions in a cohesive way is the sense of unity among the members because of their relationship with Jesus Christ. Unity is the hallmark of the Church and also among its members. Where there is unity I believe God acts in wonderful and mighty ways and that is a pleasant thing to behold. The second element is sense of order in parish. It is only when there is an order in the church and the parish that the parish functions in a cohesive manner, bringing meaning to people lives and also order in every activity done by the parish. That is why we emphasize on a liturgical worship on Sunday as it brings a sense of order among the people as they worship together, coming from different background and also mentalities. The third element for the parish to function effectively is when each member of the parish gets a due place in the functioning of the parish. Sometimes what happens in a parish setting is that some people are always relegated to the background. Nobody knows them; they come to the church unnoticed and also go away unnoticed. The people in the parish also may sometimes unknowingly miss meeting and relating with the people that they do not know. It is here that a conscious effort has to be taken so that each member of the parish is made aware of their rightful place and contribution in the functioning of the parish. When that happens parish becomes a fellowship of people doing God's mission together in fellowship.

I wrote these three concepts with Geevarghese Achen in mind. In a matter of one month he will relinquish the charge of the vicar of Ascension Mar Thoma church and take over as the bishop secretary in New York. I am sure each and every member, young and old is going to miss this dynamic achen. He and Reena was more than a colleague to us. They were our extended family. What he brought about in the Ascension Parish is the three elements Paul emphasized in Corinthian Church. He brought about unity, brought about order in the total administration of the parish and also other spiritual activities like worship and prayer meeting and finally gave a rightful place to each and everyone in the functioning of the parish. He leaves behind a wonderful legacy for the next achen to follow and also for the parishioners to comprehend that this is the way that a parish has to function.
